Why train accident claims are complex

Rail cases often involve multiple agencies, carriers, and contractors, with layers of federal and state regulations. Early investigation and evidence preservation are critical.

Top causes of train and Metrolink accidents

- Human error such as operator distraction or signal misinterpretation
- Mechanical failures including brakes, couplers, or signal systems
- Track defects or poor infrastructure maintenance
- Excessive speed leading to derailment on curves or grades
- Collisions at grade crossings due to inadequate warnings or driver error

Multiple potentially liable parties

- Train operators and engineers
- Rail carriers (e.g., commuter lines, Amtrak) and their insurers
- Maintenance and safety contractors
- Equipment and parts manufacturers
- Government entities responsible for rail infrastructure (special deadlines apply)
